The Town Board of Martinsburg held a Special Meeting at the Municipal Offices on Cemetery Road on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 at 5:00 PM to work on the budget and discuss any other business that may come before the board. Present were: Supervisor Terrence Thisse; Councilmen Brad Allen, Darren Jantzi, and Janusz Karelus; Town Clerk Mary Kelley; Highway Superintendent Tyler Jones. Absent: Councilman Michael McGrath.

Supervisor Thisse showed budget figures he has been working on and the board reviewed them. Discussion was held on the need for rugs, shop rags, etc. and if we had a contract with CINTAS or not.

Discussion was held on Martinsburg Water #1 budget. The town has a large farm that would like to connect to the water. If they are allowed to connect, can they be shut off if the town goes over the water usage permitted by the Department of Health?

Discussion was held on the fire tax and LED street lighting. Expansion of the light district was discussed.

The next budget meeting will be October 13, 2020 at 5:00 PM and fire contracts will be discussed at that time also.

Councilman Allen made a motion, seconded by Councilman Jantzi to adjourn at 6:40 PM. All were in favor. Motion carried.
