WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS GLENFIELD WATER/SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Present: Deputy Supervisor Douglas Dietrich, Councilman Michael McGrath; Town Clerk Mary Kelley; Highway Superintendent Tyler Jones; Matt Cooper, Anthony Young and Brett McVoy from Barton and Loguidice. Points discussed:

- SAM renewal
- Funding – CDBG funds will be used for distribution costs; EFC – can take out a three year short term loan to get through construction; EFC grant/loan would be for 30 years – need to complete financing application
- Review project objectives and scope of work
- Field Work – existing distribution system verification; basement surveys/lateral locations; initial fire department well investigations; existing wells and water treatment plant investigations
- Full service connection will be made to homes – approximately 60 new curb stops
- Public hearings could be held at 3-G Fire Department
- Another firm will do inspection (minority firm) to comply with minority regulations (26% has to be subbed out to minorities)
- Discussed additional lateral study for sewer project
