SPECIAL MEETING

The Town Board of Martinsburg held a Special Meeting, Monday, July 8, 2019 at 9:00 AM at the Municipal Building to discuss the Glenfield Water Improvement Project and any other matter that might come before the board. Present were: Supervisor Terrence Thisse; Councilmen Douglas Dietrich, Janusz Karelus, Brad Allen and Michael McGrath; Town Clerk Mary Kelley; Anthony Young from Barton and Loguidice.

Mr. Young discussed the Environmental Assessment form that was filled out for the Glenfield Water Project. It has been determined that part of River Street is in the 100 year flood zone. Councilman Allen made a motion, seconded by Councilman Karelus to amend Section 5 – Impact on Flooding – of the Full Environmental Assessment Form by checking yes to “The proposed action may result in development on lands subject to flooding”.
